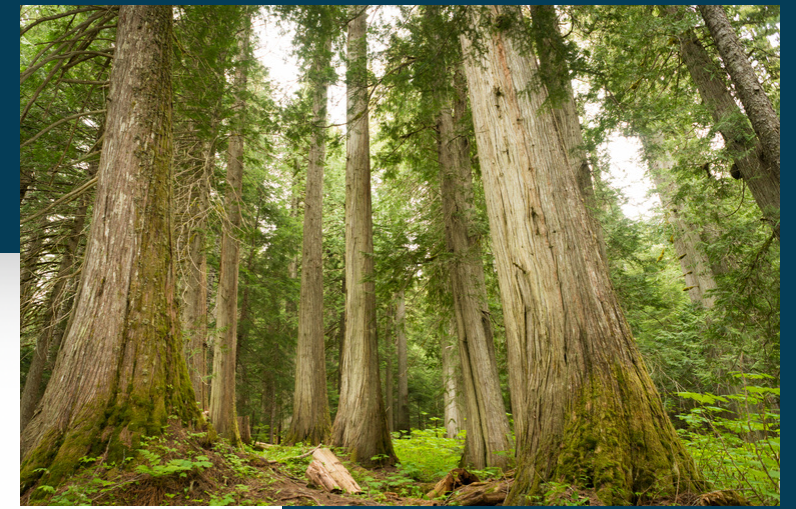

# Representation in Programming

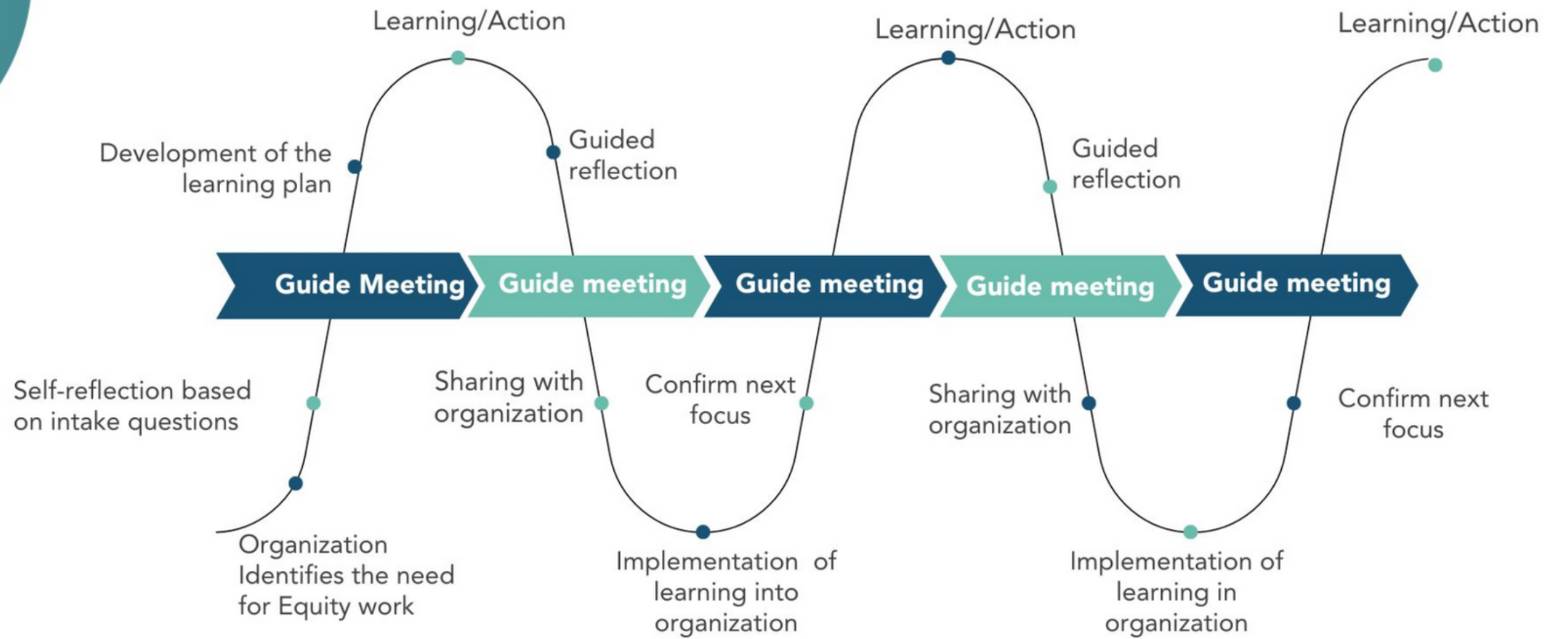
Use this section to assess the diversity of your programming in 2023 for the **same/comparable project**. Estimate the number of artists presented with representation from the following groups.
