# MESSAGE FROM THE COUNCIL

Thank you for your generous support of the Ottawa Arts Council. The LUCK! event has always held a special significance for me. As the daughter of an art gallery owner, I began collecting pieces in the late 70s, and almost every free space in my home is filled with pieces that complement my life story.

A visit to Bill Staubi's home earlier this year confirmed that I wasn't alone in my love for visual art, with hundreds of pieces showcased on his walls that told his story - a story about the importance of supporting emerging artists and the validation they feel when a collector falls in love with the work and chooses to support their continued practice.

Bill has left an indelible mark on the arts sector in Ottawa. He champions, he supports, and he shows up. We are incredibly grateful to him for his donation of works from his private collection, with the intention, as Bill says, "for the work to find a new home and a new life."

Next month we will officially merge with the incomparable team at Arts Network Ottawa, creating a new arts service organization, co-created with community in mind and artists at the centre. We will grow in capacity, and make space for the important deep work our sector needs, igniting partnerships, championing collaboration and galvanizing the sector into activation.

Ottawa Arts Council wouldn't be where we are today without your continued support. With donor support in high-demand, and with so many nonprofits struggling to make ends meet, the fact that you chose to invest in our fundraiser to support our work is something we do not take for granted.

Thank you for making that investment in the Council, and for supporting one of our community champions in sharing his collection back into the community. We hope you leave tonight with something incredibly special that will remind you that you helped make a difference.

# Thank you BILL STAUBI

William (Bill) Staubi began supporting artists and their work in 1978 when he purchased five works from a group of emerging artists after helping them hang their show. He broadened his support to the Ottawa arts community by continuing to collect, promoting artists and their events, mentoring and supporting individual artists and groups such the Enriched Bread Artists, The Decommissioners, and others.

A generous donor to arts organizations and fundraisers, Bill supported SAW Gallery's acquisition of a limited edition set of General Idea's AIDS prints and donated 40 portraits of early leaders of Ottawa's Queer community now hanging in City Hall.



In recent years Bill has donated 100 works to the City of Ottawa collection, and is in negotiations with the Ottawa Art Gallery, the Thunder Bay Gallery, and others to further ensure artists' work is formally recognized, conserved, and publicly displayed.

Last year, Bill was diagnosed with Stage 4 liver cancer. He's faced his prognosis head on and, in true Staubi fashion, has been donating his extensive art collection to various organizations to assist in their fundraising goals, grow their own collections, offering further recognition and prominence for the artists.

Bill's legacy will live on through his powerful advocacy for artists and his unfailing support for the organizations that grow and support them.
